I would like to welcome everyone back to school. We look forward to having a very successful school year as we focus on teaching students, building positive relationships, and doing our best each day to provide the very best education for our students.

I am excited to be part Keya Paha County Schools and look forward to meeting all the students, parents, staff and community members.

Below you will find important information for beginning the 2017-18 school year. Please read and feel free to contact the school if you have questions.

The first day of school will be Wednesday, August 16, 2017. School hours: KPHS from 8:00-3:30; Springview Elementary from 8:00-3:30; Pleasantview from 8:00-3:30.

Students will have 3 days to change classes. Class changes may be made with Mrs. Franklin, with parent approval, up until 3:30 P.M. Friday, August 18<sup>th</sup>.

Devices (iPads) will be distributed to all students in grades 7 thru 12 on August 16 during school. 7<sup>th</sup> grade students and new students need to come to the school with their parent/guardian and become acquainted with the device program. You can come to the high school office starting Monday, August 7<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. to Tuesday, August 15<sup>th</sup>.

Sports physicals, Medical Release form, NSAA Consent form, and Concussion form must be completed by students in grades 7-12 prior to the first practice. No student will be allowed to practice until those forms are completed, signed and on file.

**A general physical must be completed by all incoming Kindergarten and 7<sup>th</sup> grade students.** The sports physical will fulfill this requirement for 7<sup>th</sup> graders. These forms are available at the High School office or on the school web site. All incoming Kindergartners must also have an eye exam prior to starting school.

Breakfast prices for K-12 is \$1.40, while lunch prices this year for K-6 is \$2.25 and for 7-12 is \$2.50. If at all possible we would like to have a portion of milk, breakfast, and hot lunches paid for before school starts. Checks for breakfast and hot lunch should be made payable to Keya Paha County Schools. All forms can be dropped off at the High School.
