Dear Parents/Gaudians,

Welcome to a brand new year in Keya Paha County Schools! We are glad to have you as part of our school family and hope you are looking forward to the 2018-2019 academic year.

Below you will find important information for beginning the 2018-2019 school year. Please reand and feel free to contact the school if you have questions.

The first day of school will be Wednesday, August 15, 2018. School hours for KPHS and Springview Elementary are 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Students will have 3 days to change classes. Class changes may be made with Mrs. Franklin, with parent approval, up until 3:30 P.M. Friday, August 17th.

Computers will be distributed to all students in grades 7 through 12 on August 15 during school. 7th and 8th grade students will be able to take a computer home only once a week. 9th through 12th grade students will have to pay a \$35.00 fee to be able to take the computer home nightly. You can come to the high school office starting Monday, August 6th from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. to Tuesday, August 14th.

Sports physicals, Medical Release form, NSAA Consent form, and Concussion form must be completed by students in grades 7-12 prior to the first practice. No student will be allowed to practice until those forms are completed, signed and on file.

A general physical must be completed by all incoming Kindergarten and 7th grade students. The sports physical will fulfill this requirement for 7th graders. These forms are available at the High School office or on the school website. All incoming Kindergartners must also have an eye exam prior to the start of school.

Breakfast prices for K-12 is \$1.40, while lunch prices this year for K-6 is \$2.30 and for 7-12 is \$2.55. If at all possible we would like to have a portion of milk, breakfast, and hot lunches paid for before school starts. Checks for breakfast and hot lunch should be made payable to Keya Paha County Schools. All forms can be dropped off at the High School.
